RESOLUTION 15-07**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE HEALTH PLAN

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Assembly passed House Bill 154 allowing governmental units with less than 1,000 employees to enroll their employees in the State Health Plan for teachers, state employees and state retirees; and

WHEREAS, the State Health Plan appears to offer comparable benefits to the Town of Holden Beach employees' existing plan and to be cost effective; and

WHEREAS, the legislation requires that a local governmental unit pass a resolution expressing its desire to participate in the State Health Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that:

1. The Town of Holden Beach would like to participate in the State Health Plan, should research prove that the State Health Plan is beneficial to its employees and cost effective; and
2. The Board directs the Town Manager to pursue possible participation in the State Health Plan.
