

RESOLUTION 15-20
RESOLUTIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD RELATING TO THE DRAFTING OF A PROPOSED NOISE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, at the regular Board of Commissioners meeting on September 8, 2015, after considering call for the adoption of a more stringent noise ordinance for almost one year, the Board of Commissioners unanimously directed the Planning and Zoning Board to draft a proposed noise ordinance based upon those parts of the recently adopted noise ordinance of Brunswick County;

WHEREAS, effective as of this date, the Board of Commissioners has adopted amended Chapter 92 of the Town's Ordinance to adopt a new noise ordinance,

WHEREAS, pursuant to §30.08 of the Town's Ordinances, the members of all boards and committees appointed by the Board of Commissioners "serve at the pleasure of the [Board of Commissioners],"

BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby withdraws its directive that the Planning and Zoning Board draft a proposed noise ordinance, and

BE IT, THEREFORE, FURTHER RESOLVED, that, effective immediately, the membership of the Planning and Zoning Board is hereby reconstituted as follows:

- (1) the regular members of the Planning and Zoning Board shall be: Vicki Myers (a current regular member); Bob Hunter (a current regular member); Mark Fleishhauer (a current regular member); and Michael Sullivan (a current alternate member); and
- (2) the alternate members of the Planning and Zoning Board shall be: David Burris (a current regular member) and Peter Pallas (a current alternate member);
- (3) one regular member seat shall remain vacant pending completion of a nomination and election process to be conducted by the Board of Commissioners in the manner provided for in the Rules of Procedure of the Board of Commissioners, which process shall be conducted and completed during the month of January 2016.
