

**TOWN OF HOLDEN BEACH
ORDINANCE 17-11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HOLDEN BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CHAPTER 94: BEACH REGULATIONS (SECTION 94.03 FRONTAL DUNE POLICY
AND REGULATIONS)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Holden Beach, North Carolina that the Holden Beach Code of Ordinances, Chapter 94: Beach Regulations be amended as follows:

Section One: Amend Section 94.03(A) Frontal Dune Policy and Regulations as follows (new wording in red):

(A) *Definition.* For the purpose of this section, **FRONTAL DUNES** shall mean the dunes designated by ~~a NC State Division of Coastal Management official~~ **the Town's Local Certified CAMA Official** as the "frontal dunes", otherwise, they are the first mounds of sand located landward of the ocean beach with sufficient vegetation, height, and configuration to offer protection from ocean storms. Considering the fact that oceanfront property limits extend to the mean high water mark, the frontal dune may be located on private property.

Section Two: The Town Clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to American Legal Publishing for inclusion in the next published supplement to the Holden Beach Code of Ordinances.

Section Three: This ordinance shall be effective the 20th day of September, 2017.
