

COMMISSIONER SULLIVAN WAS BORN AND RAISED IN NEW YORK, NEW YORK. HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR 25 YEARS, RETIRING AS A LIEUTENANT. HE WAS A PATROL OFFICER AND SUPERVISOR AND LATER AN OFFICER AND SUPERVISOR IN A UNIT TASKED WITH THE SUPPRESSION OF VIOLENT STREET CRIME AND THE APPREHENSION OF VIOLENT FELONS. UPON PROMOTION TO LIEUTENANT, HE WAS ASSIGNED TO THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET WHERE HE MANAGED A BUDGET OF ONE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS AND OVERSAW THE COMPUTERIZATION OF THE TIME AND PAYROLL RECORD SYSTEMS.

LATER HE REPRESENTED TWO OF THE LARGEST COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNERS IN NEW YORK CITY FOR ALL LIABILITY CLAIMS. HE LATER BECAME THE MANAGING COUNSEL FOR COMMERCIAL CLAIMS FOR NATIONWIDE INSURANCE, A FORTUNE 100 CORPORATION.
