



PROCLAMATION FOR MANDATORY EVACUATION

WHEREAS, the Town of Holden Beach adopted a State of Emergency Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance empowers the Mayor of the Town of Holden Beach by proclamation to order the evacuation of the Town of Holden Beach in the event of an emergency situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. Alan Holden, Mayor of the Town of Holden Beach, do order the following measures to be taken immediately:

1. Immediate MANDATORY evacuation for non-resident renters and visitors of the Town of Holden Beach is declared with said parties to be off the island by 12:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 11, 2018.
2. Immediate MANDATORY evacuation for EVERYONE in the Town of Holden Beach is declared with said parties to be off the island by Wednesday, September 12, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. The bridge is subject to being closed sooner if winds are sustained at 45 MPH or higher;
3. A roadblock set at the bridge at 12:00 p.m. on the 11th day of September, 2018 to restrict entrance to the island;
4. A command post shall be established at the Town Hall until such time Town operations are moved to the Emergency Operations Center at 1044 Sabbath Home Road;
5. All persons shall remain off the island until allowed by proclamation to return.
